Dr. Morlet received his medical degree in 1989 at the National Autonomous University of México (U.N.A.M.), before he finished his Medical training, he worked for the Department of Epidemiology at the Ministry of Health in México City (1990-1992). He earned a speciality in Psychiatry at the National Institute of Psychiatry "Ramón de la Fuente Muñiz" in México City in 1994 and completed a Master Degree in Liaison Psychiatry at the Institute of Medical Sciences "Salvador Zubiran and Medical Psychotherapy at the U.N.A.M. During 15 years he worked as and assigned Medical Doctor and Head of Psychiatric outpatients at the National Institute of Psychiatry "Ramón de la Fuente Muñiz". Dr. Morlet provided, for 13 years, psychiatric consultation at the Department of Neurology and Psychiatry at the National Institute of Medical Sciences "Salvador Zubirán" as an assigned Medical Doctor.

Dr. Morlet is certified by the Mexican council of Psychiatry an International Member of Postgraduate Association at Harvard Medical School, the European Psychiatric Association and member of the Massachusetts General Hospital Psychiatry Academy. He has served as principal investigator in clinical research studies and has held a number of teaching appointments. In addition, he has given National and International presentations in the fields of mood and anxiety disorders. Since November of 2012 he is working in private practice, neuropsychopharmacology and clinical Psychiatry projects in Veracruz, Ver., México.
